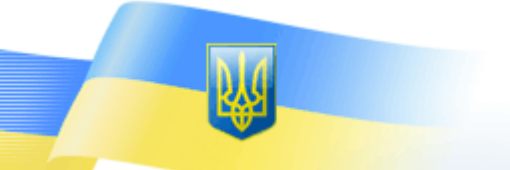

The Coordination Bureau:

- Monitors and controls implementation of the state policy on preparation and holding in Ukraine the final part of the UEFA Euro 2012;
- Coordinates activities and provides support to UEFA Euro 2012 National Coordinators;
- Drafts strategies and plans on championship preparation;
- Coordinates and monitors activities of the central and local authorities related to the preparation and holding the UEFA Euro 2012;
- Provides recommendations for central and local authorities on successful implementation of UEFA Euro 2012 requirements;
- Coordinates cooperation with UEFA and Polish Side on UEFA Euro 2012 issues;
- Analyzes the draft laws and government regulations on preparation and holding the championship;
- Drafts government regulations on preparation and holding the championship;
- Provides official information on progress in preparation to the UEFA Euro 2012;
- Cooperates with NGOs involved into the process of preparation to the championship;
- Performs other functions according to the national law.

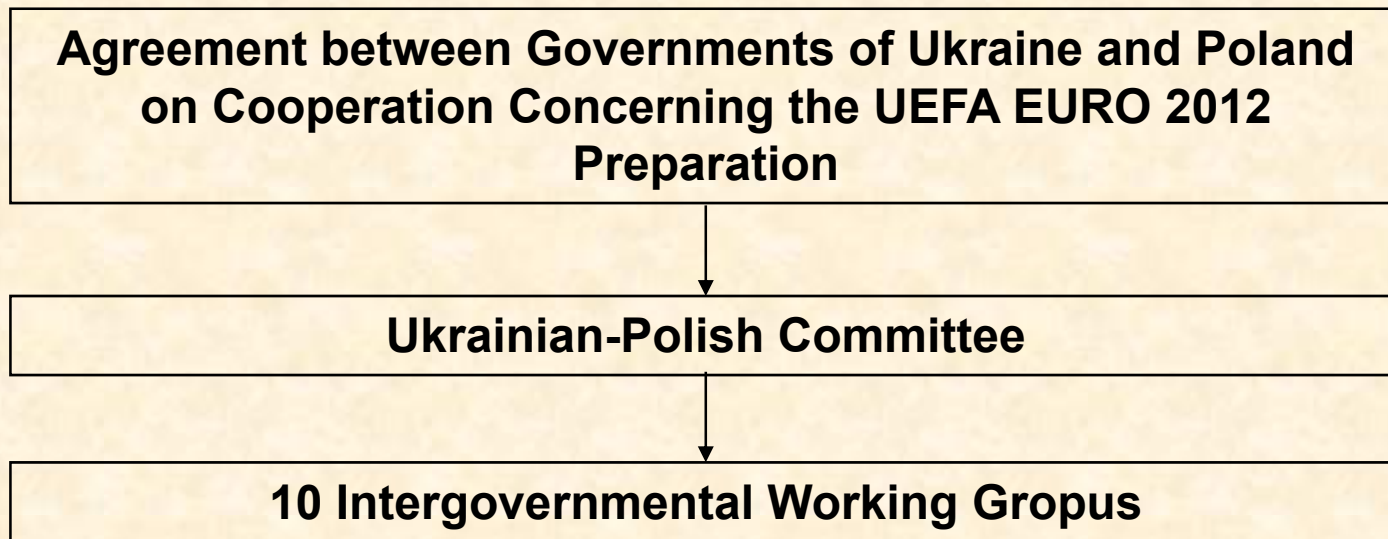
Draft law “On the changes to the law on preparation and holding of final part of UEFA Euro 2012 in Ukraine”

Improvement of the process of preparation and holding UEFA Euro 2012 in the following spheres:

- Distribution of responsibilities, functions and tasks of central and local authorities;
- Definition of ways of cooperation with UEFA and FFU;
- Specification of the process of building projects, concerning the necessity of holding UEFA Euro 2012 and buying out of land areas;
- Establishing the procedure of fulfillment of the governmental guarantees given to UEFA.

The State Program on UEFA EURO 2012 Preparations

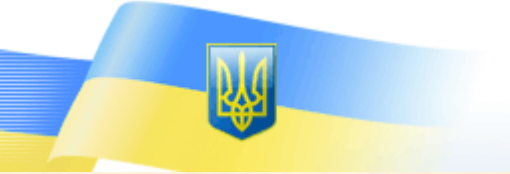
- Adopted on 22 February 2008 by Government Resolution No.107;
- Consists of 21 tasks according to the UEFA requirements and Government Guarantees;
- Allocated Funds for 2008-2012:

total - **159,98 bil.hrn.**

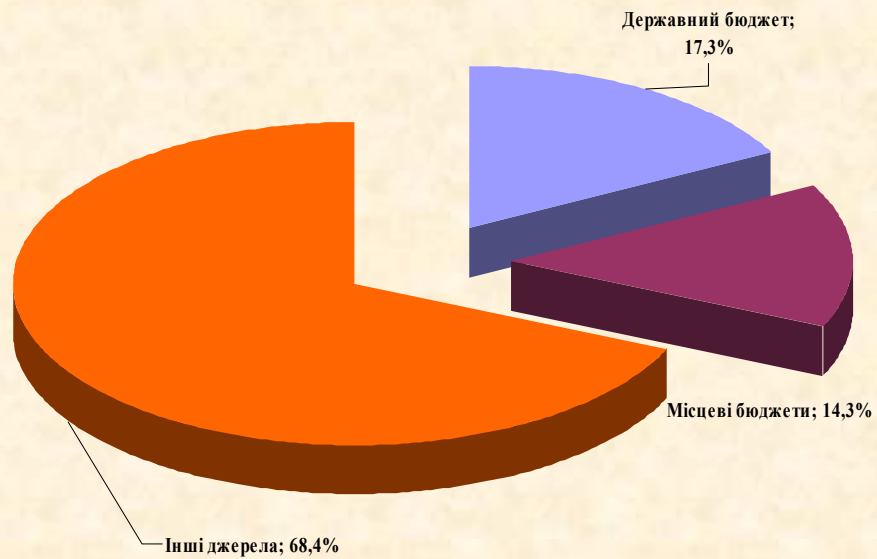
state budget - **27,54 bil.hrn.** (17,3 %);

local budgets of the host cities - **22,93 bil.grn.** (14,3%);

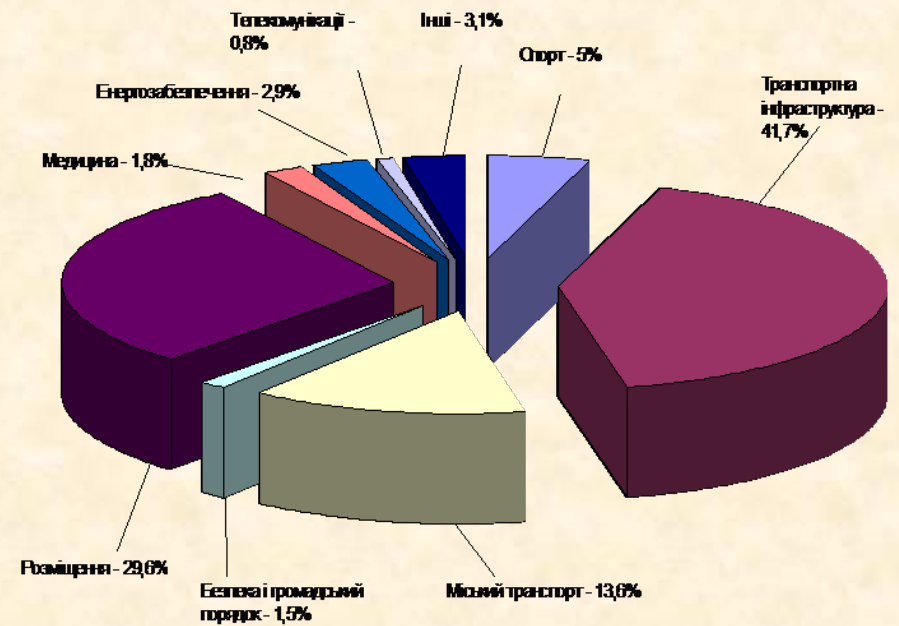
other sources - **109,5 bil.grn.** (68,4%).

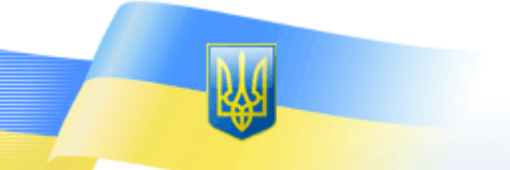


Структура загальних прогнозних обсягів фінансування Програми, %

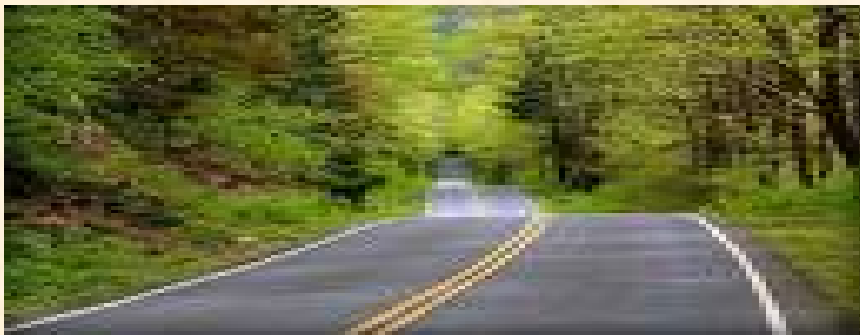
